FROM THE LAST MEETING: The speaker at our last meeting was Arzur Yilmaz. She discussed the City of Clemson Farmers Market which is now open from 4 pm to 8 pm on Fridays. The location on Hwy 123 was chosen as a visible high traffic area which minimized the impact on traffic congestion in the City. They currently have 24 vendors participating. The fee for vendors is \$25 for the season, which runs from May 14 to October 1. Products for sale at the Farmers Market must be produced (or grown) by the vendor.

PID Bill West reported on the International Convention in Australia. PDG Gene Speiss was elected as an International Director and will serve on the Constitution & By-Laws Committee. Over 14,000 were registered for the convention and the S. C. delegation was very active.
